Camilla School Running Club Competes at the 33rd Annual Edmonton Journal Indoor Games



We have had a very successful experience qualifying for the Edmonton Journal Indoor Games. The results for Relay Teams and Individuals are outstanding and we are swelling with pride. We are excited for the relay teams that have advanced and are so impressed with our novice teams. We battled frigid temperatures, illness, and conflicting schedules of provincial level sports (basketball, soccer and hockey) and yet these remarkable students still worked together as a team raced their heart out. The results leading up to Saturday, March 19th are as follows:

Elementary Girls A Team (8x200m) – Currently ranked 33rd as they were 2nd in their heat and are ranked after all heat winners. They have the 7th fastest time of the event. Official time: 4:32.00. Qualified to the quarter-finals

Elementary Boys A Team (8x200m) – Currently ranked 51st with a photo finish 2nd place in their heat. Official time: 4:43.30. Qualified to the quarter-finals

Elementary Girls B Team (8x200m) – Ranked 102 out of 188 teams. Official time: 5:10.00

Elementary Boys B Team (8x200m) – Ranked 162 out of 199 teams. Official time: 5:21.90

Jr. High Mixed Relay Team (8x200m) – Ranked 12th overall. Official time: 4:19.00. Qualified to Semi-finals

Teachers Mixed Team (4x200) – Ranked 2nd overall. Official time: 2:04.9. Qualified to the finals. **TEACHERS finish in first place – WINNING GOLD!!**
