FRIENDS OF CAMILLA IS REQUESTING YOUR HELP TO DECIDE WHAT IS NEEDED FOR OUR SCHOOL AND WHAT THE FUTURE FUNDRAISING EFFORTS WILL SUPPORT

In the few short years that the Friends of Camilla (FOC) group has been functioning at Camilla School (since 2004/05 school years), many improvements within our Camilla community have been accomplished.

When FOC initially began their function of raising dollars for the school, the proceeds were used to help pay for field trips and bussing. Continuing forward, the committees' efforts were focussed on building a *\$300,000 Grounds Enhancement Project*, which included gazebos and a new playground for the primary/elementary schoolyard. This project was completed in the 2008/09 school year.

Also in the 2008/09 school year, FOC continued to help alleviate some of the costs of field trips, assisted in the purchase of the new sound system in the gym, and funded the recording of our Camilla School Song.

During this current school year, a portion of the fundraised proceeds from the Casino last year has allowed Camilla to purchase such great items such as: promethean boards (smart boards), technical equipment (cameras & a wii game system), music equipment and phys.ed. equipment.

FOC currently has several suggestions that are possible projects for the future fundraising efforts; however, your input is really needed before we can go forward. We're looking for parents, students, teachers and other staff to let us know what you'd like to see your fundraised dollars go towards.

Some of the ideas that have been brought forward are:

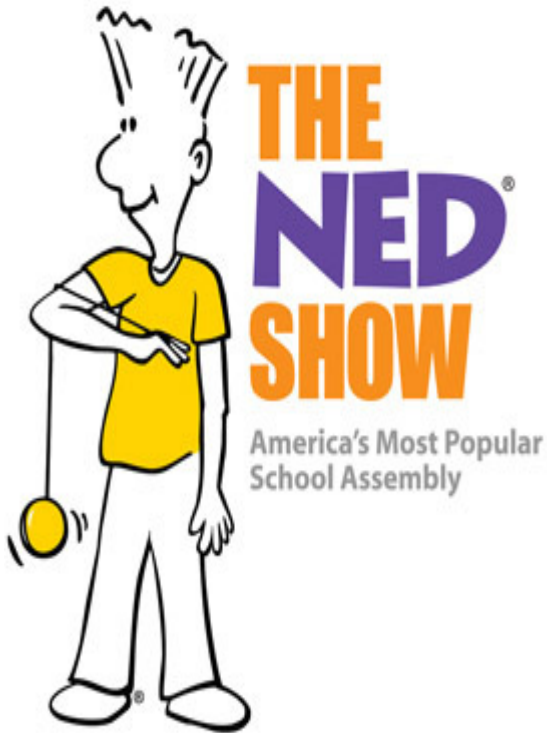
- Climbing wall in the gym (approximate cost \$50,000)
- Addition to the 5-6 playground (approximate cost \$60,000)
- Rubberized running track and enhancements to our track and field (approximate cost \$320,000)
- Stage upgrades (including a large screen for movie projection)
- Laptops to be used in classrooms instead of the existing computer lab (library)
- Canoes
- Golf equipment
- Cross country skis
