## Ecovoyageurs – The Amazing Race Continues...

We would like to draw attention to living in a “greener” world and to the responsibilities that we have as global citizens to take care of our planet as we journey through our lives. We will look at our own habits and the “carbon footprint” that we are creating and how we can reduce the imprint. Classes can look at the way we use our waste water, and food and take responsibility for the garbage that we create. Many of these ideas and topics have already been part of our daily instruction.

Throughout the week we will – recycle juice boxes with proceeds going toward the grade 1L Tree Huggers Foundation – otherwise known as “let’s plant some trees in our school yard”.

Paper Recycling – classes collect their daily paper waste to be gathered to raise awareness as to how wasteful we are and that recovery is possible. How much paper=1 tree?

**Monday, May 2 – Afternoon assembly to launch the spirit of the week’s events.** Tentative activities may include:

Slide show of the Camilla School “BEFORE” the voyage, showing the various ways that we are wasteful (garbage, litter, lunches, messy etc)., The viewing of Dr. Seuss’ The Lorax, Drama skits depicting the theme, Choral speaking from classes, Poems with background music for mood and effect, etc.

**Tuesday, May 3 – Water – Bring a water bottle to school.** Start gaining points for using a refillable bottle.

Guest speakers to read “Green” stories to various classes., Cross grade DEAR time to recycle their favorite story (story telling or reading), Identify your carbon footprint and make a plan (class or individual, map or web, etc), Measure/weigh/count the amount of garbage created by lunches alone. Record results and plan a strategy for less waste, etc.

**Wednesday, May 4 – Food – 5N Eating Habits**

Gain points for lunches that are nutritious, natural, near, not packaged, now., Canada Food Guide Games – daily physical activity

**Thursday, May 5 – First Nations Expo and Virtual Museum** – A tribute to the First Nations. An exhibit by the grade 7’s in the gym.

**Friday, May 6 – “Put a CAP on Waste”** Wear your hat for a \$1 (proceeds going to a charitable cause) Noon Recess – Garbage Pickup around the school and community. Classes will be given certain zones to cover. Volunteer your time to put garbage in its place., Weather permitting – Outdoor school assembly at the conclusion of lunch recess to tip our hats to the efforts of our school for making a positive contribution to living “greener”., Reveal Camilla’s Carbon Footprint and compare to Canada’s.

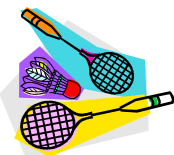

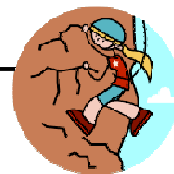
