

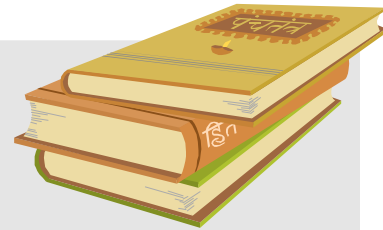

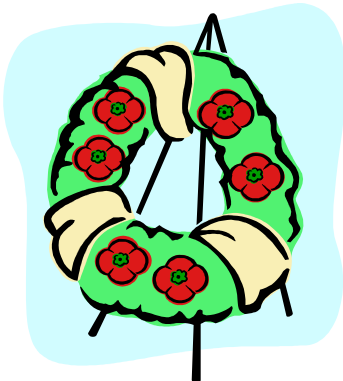
Parents/Guardians are asked to call the school to schedule your parent/teacher interview on Friday November 4th. Appointments are made for K-9 students.

If your son/daughter is not participating, it is expected that they will be at school.

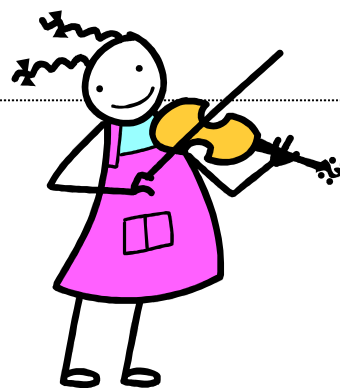

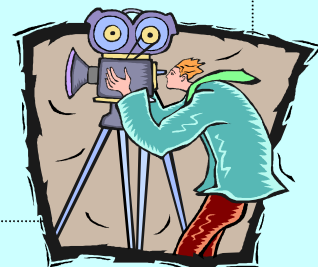

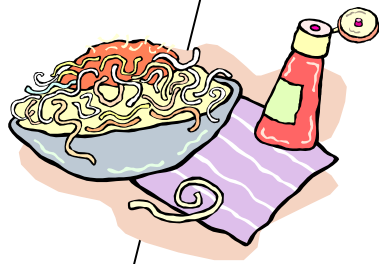
