



RQB History Book Project Volunteers Needed

If you currently live in the RQB area, participate in organizations in RQB, and/or if you attended or your children now attend Camilla School and you would like to be a part of the new community book.

Here's how:

1. Complete a Family Page to share your current (between 1980 and 2022) personal and/or family connection with RQB. Contact the research team at rqbhistory@gmail.com to get a Family Page template that will guide you through the writing and formatting process.
2. Register your family with us to receive updates about the book, order a book and sign up to be in the book. [Click here to learn more.](#)

Here's what you can do if your family is in *The Wheels of Time*.

1. **Contact** the RQB Early History research team at rqbhistory@gmail.com to get a document containing the references to your family in *The Wheels of Time*.
2. **Review and update** your family history. Talk with other family members to ensure its accuracy and completeness.
3. **Proofread** your edited family history when it is formatted onto a Family Page by the research volunteers (or someone in your family).

Currently our small team of volunteers is busy with the following:

1. **Research:** Gathering family histories (1880s to 1970s) from *The Wheels of Time*.
2. **Computer work:** Developing templates for new entries for the 1980-present day section of the book
3. **Publicity:**

- Talking to, emailing and phoning anyone who has expressed an interest in the RQB history book project
- Distributing the online form so people can pre-order the book
- Expanding our list of community members who may want to volunteer to help with the project
- Building a list of community members who may want to share their family stories in the new book
- Encouraging community members to nominate others who are outstanding in RQB area so we can recognize the volunteers among us.

Here's what else you can do:

1. Share the pre-order/registration form with as many people in the community as you can:
 - Email, phone, word of mouth or social media
2. Email and/or post updates at West Country Hearth. We want to encourage community members there to get involved. Share the information with friends who may have relatives at West Country Hearth.
3. Join our core volunteer team: Help with organizational tasks such as
 - Sending email
 - Editing, proofreading family pages and volunteer pages
 - Collect and organize photos
 - Gather submissions from community members
 - Talk with people about their connection with RQB
 - Help to collect stories about volunteers

We need more volunteers. You can work within your time limits and use your strengths and talents. No experience necessary. Take a minute to consider how you might be able to help. Maybe you have a suggestion on what you might be able to offer. We are open to suggestions! We would be happy to chat with you.
