New Business

- Glow Dance Raised approx. \$925.93. Feedback was that it was well received. Discussion was held around suggestions of maybe the Rec board to take it on if they want to have a beer gardens. A first aid station would be of benefit next year. And clearer messaging that the event is not a drop and go. Parents are required to stay.
- Grab & Go Concerns Concerns were brought forth about frequent flyers and running out of food. Discussion resulted that ultimately it doesn't matter who needs it. If they are hungry they should be able to access the food without fear of judgment. Asked Dan what he sees as the actual issue. The food needs to come on a more regulated/scheduled basis. Some weeks are forgotten or food comes half way through the week. Budget does not need to be increased. Our purpose is to provide food to kids that are hungry regardless of who it is. CSC will have a discussion outside this meeting to strategize how to ensure reminders are given

to the volunteer on the schedule to ensure food is purchased and presented each Monday morning.

- Year End Hot Dog Lunch Hot dogs/chips and water will be provided. A volunteer will be required from CSC to purchase items and will need volunteers to run it. Dan will advise of the date. CSC will discuss outside of this meeting to arrange volunteers.
