Principal / Vice Principal

- 1. Ski Trip went really well
- 2. Staff Shortages throughout division with a lot of staff out sick
- 3. Parent Teacher Interviews are this week. Any feedback?
 - a. Online booking system works well
- 4. Question was asked regarding the retiring teachers and when will the Principal know who will be filling those positions?
 - a. They need to wait until budgets are released, but should know in May
- 5. Athletics
 - a. Basketball both teams got second place
 - b. Badminton is currently underway
 - c. Running Club has wrapped up and this will be Ms. Shulhan's last year
- 6. Playground
 - a. Sturgeon division has done an audit of all school playgrounds
 - b. The old playground at Camilla requires repairs and initial cost is \$48,180. The largest cost is the removal of the sand; this is not too code.
 - c. Rough estimate is that the school will need to cover approx. \$38,000 of the repairs
 - d. Principal to look a fixing smaller items as soon as possible
 - e. There are grants available and Kevin will review options
 - f. Suggestion was made of a playground committee
 - g. Principal to meet with the division and go through all of the areas for repair and gain an understanding of the deadline on when these repairs need to be completed.
 - h. This should be added to our agenda as a standing item going forward.
 - i. Footloose decision has been made that a production of this magnitude will not be done next year. Principal would like to look at other ways to support Fine Arts.
 - j. Requests have been made to look at an Academy at Camilla
 - i. Kevin will not be moving forward with this
 - ii. The district is reviewing the term "academy" and they have set a very specific criteria that schools must meet in order to be classified as an academy and the bar has been set quite high.
 - ii. Do not feel this is a good option for our community
